Calendar of Events

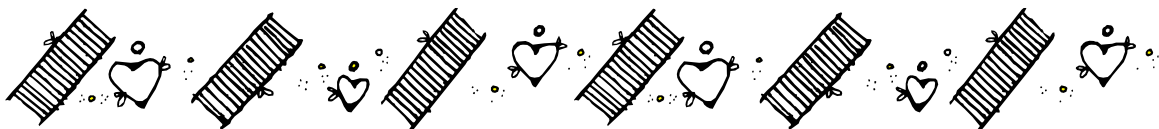
February 2 – Scholastic Book Fair at Rainbow School. Located in ½ of room 1. The book fair is a Preschool Book Fair. Come and check out our fair.
